I was delighted to be able to share out Ofsted report with you earlier this week, which confrms that we continue to be a good school. Here are some of the highlights:

'Each day is active and busy for pupils at Nevill Road Junior School. Pupils arrive at school happy to learn. They said that their teachers make learning interesting.'

'Pupils play well together. Skilled staff support pupils to resolve any falling-out quickly, for example through restorative conversations. Leaders are quick to deal with any incidents of bullying. This helps pupils to feel safe.'

'Leaders are vigilant when identifying the additional needs of pupils with SEND. Teachers are furnished with detailed information and training, which helps them to support pupils with SEND effectively. Teachers are skilful at making appropriate adaptations to the delivery of the curriculum for these pupils. Leaders work well with outside agencies, when required, to make sure that pupils with SEND receive the extra support that they need.' 'Staff are proud to work at the school.'
