Jewellery School Policy

Please note that we have a no jewellery policy, earrings must be removed for PE and swimming lessons. This information can be found on the school website and also communicated termly through the year group newsletters.

Where a child has recently had their ears pierced, they are permitted to wear plasters until they are able to take them out themselves. However, guidance from the Local Authority states:

The pupil's physical participation in the lesson may need to be modified to avoid any contact/collisions as taping does not prevent injury if ears are rubbed or they bump into others or equipment

Staff should avoid applying the tape & parents or pupils should apply themselves

Staff need to monitor that the tape does not come off

Participation in some higher risk activities may still not be appropriate even if modified – in this case pupils can still be involved in the learning process in other ways eg peer assessment etc
