Key Priorities



Our ASPIRE focus this half term is <u>Imagination</u> to encourage the children to be creative and develop their thinking skills through a range of activities and subject areas. At the Junior School we have been using DEAL strategies (drama to engage in active learning).







Unfortunately the Chinese maths specialists will not be visiting school as planned, however Mrs Jordan will be working with staff across school to showcase everything that she learnt in Shanghai during her two week visit. Here are the key priorities in maths that we are working on this year.

<u>Priority 4</u> - To improve the quality of education for all children in maths through:

- Embedding the maths mastery lesson structure so that it is consistent across school.
- Developing teachers subject knowledge and pedagogy through staff participating in Teacher Research Groups
- Developing the use of practical resources in maths lessons.
- Developing teachers questioning throughout lessons.
- Securing mental calculation strategies for all children in Years 3 and 4.
- Review how times tables are taught across school in line with the new check.
- Quality first teaching that meets the needs of all children.

Music and Art ASPIRE day

On the last day of term, the children took part in a music and art ASPIRE day with a Chinese theme. Every class listened to traditional Chinese music as well as pieces that have been inspired by China. Using glockenspiels and garage band, the children composed pieces of music based upon the pentatonic scale. A range of art activities also took place based upon traditional skills including calligraphy and shadow puppets.
