
Message from the Governors

Mrs Cliff will continue to Track and Trace for those children who are attending school. Please email <u>covid@nevillroad-</u> <u>jun.stockport.sch.uk</u> if your child has a positive Covid19 test. Please include:

- the child's name
- the child's class
- the date symptoms started
- the date the test was taken
- the date of the positive result
- the date your child was last in school
- whether your child attended before or after school club and the dates they attended
- your contact number.

Please do not send your child in to school if they display any of the Covid 19 symptoms and ensure that you book a test for your child straight away.
