Targeted

Can do approach for all children. All children to complete challenges during lesson. Differentiated equipment where needed to aid physical abilities. Sentence stems to aid answering questions - linked to question types. Repetition of these sentence stems. Visuals used to support learners. Agreed lesson structure throughout school. Any printed resources are Dyslexic friendly. Use of vocabulary cards as prompts in each lesson. Opportunities for direct feedback during the lesson. Clarifying vocabulary and demonstrate to ensure all can access the words and their meaning. Collaborative learning and use of talk partners. Lots of opportunities for self and peer support and self and peer assessment. Formative assessments throughout the lesson. In lesson, live lesson feedback and support. Guided support and independent practice. Recap prior learning in each lesson. Verbal praise and next steps. Clear sequence of planned lessons. Lesson plans to include adaptations to aid less able, those children with SEND and more able. Progression map of skills from Year s 3– 6 available for different areas of PE. A pre-learning assessment to be used at the start of a unit to inform the teacher of the skills which need to be taught and practised. Discussions about winning and losing and how we feel about this. Open discussion about skills we are good at and what we need to improve. The use of positive language is modelled and expected when playing team games.
