Mrs Taylor has taken our netball teams to two events through the Autumn Term. The children have really enjoyed putting their skills to the test against a wide range of schools.

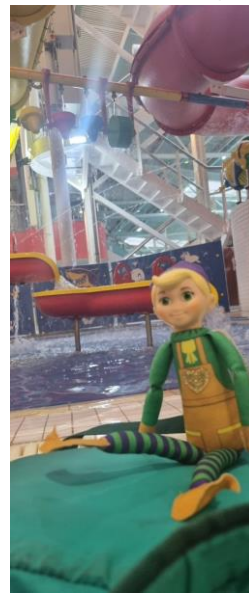


### Year 5 & 6 Tag Rugby
