



## Nevill Road Junior School – Covid 19 Catch Up Premium Spending Report DRAFT COPY

This policy sets out the plans for how the Covid 19 Catch Up Premium will be spent at Nevill Road Junior School to enable children to 'catch up' on their missed learning due lockdown.

Catch Up Premium Total: £26,000

## **INTENT**

At Nevill Road Juniors, we provide a rich and deep curriculum through a thematic approach. This is in line with, but also goes beyond the requirements set out in the National Curriculum. Our curriculum promotes a love of learning and gives children the confidence to be curious, to explore and to provide opportunities for children to challenge themselves. Knowledge and skills increase as the children progress through the school and they are able to articulate what they know and what they remember with confidence and delight. We want all children to give themselves choices and to reach their full potential in preparation for their future success.

Since the full reopening of school in September 2020, we have implemented our Recovery Curriculum to enable our pupils to access the national curriculum taking into account their wellbeing and mental health needs. In order to 'catch up' on missed learning, lessons have been adapted in order to focus on key skills. For example, in Y3 the teaching of Phonics has been a priority and additional reading books have been purchased to create class libraries that follow the reading recovery reading scheme. Our maths lesson have followed the adapted White Rose lesson plans that allows children to recap on prior learning and fluency before applying to reasoning questions. We have also ensured that we continue to teach a broad and balanced curriculum by blocking subject areas to enable children to recall key knowledge and vocabulary. Additional staff have been employed to provide bespoke 'catch up' programmes for individual children and small groups as well as after school booster sessions.


