Health and Safety Reminders – Covid

If your child shows any symptoms of Covid 19 (new, continuous cough, a high temperature or loss of taste and smell) please keep them at home and take them for a PCR test and isolate until the result has been confirmed.

Close contacts under the age of 18 years and 4 months do not have to isolate and neither do adults who have been double vaccinated. School will no longer be contact tracing. Please contact NHS track and trace to report a positive case.
