WATER SAFETY



With the summer season approaching and as temperatures rise, children are tempted to cool off with a swim in a river, canal, lake or reservoir. We want to ensure that children are aware of the dangers of open water swimming.

Generally there is no supervision. The cold-water temperature can claim your life in minutes - even if you are a strong swimmer.

It's difficult to estimate the depth of the water. It may be much deeper much shallower than expected.

There are often no suitable places to get out of the water due to steep slimy banks or sides.

There is no way of knowing what lies beneath - there could be weeds, pipes, shopping trolleys, sharp metal or broken bottles.
