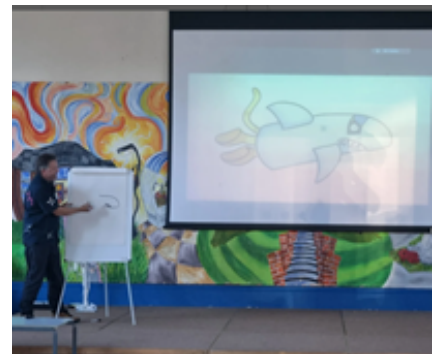

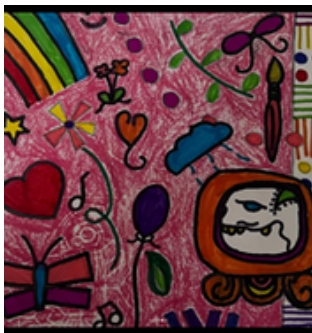
Year 3 & 4 have enjoyed listening to author Steve Webb this morning, promoting his new book Peng and Spanners.
