Home Learning

Please see the following message from the Home Learning Team:

Welcome back to Summer 2

As most of Year 6 and the teachers are now back in school, the home learning offer will look slightly different.

- Oak Academy tasks for English and Maths daily. These do not need to be submitted as the answers are given within the tasks.
- The final English task for each unit will be set as an assignment. This is a piece of writing that will need to be submitted for marking by the year group teacher, and feedback will be given. This will be made clear to you when the work is uploaded.
- 1 Science task, 1 Topic task (History or Geography), 1 Foundation subject task. Again, these will be set as assignments and will need to be submitted for marking by your year group teacher.
- · A fortnightly spelling quiz.
- An area with handwriting/motor skills activities
- A daily check in for each year group on the class stream. There is an expectation for each child to comment here at least once a week so that we know they are happy and well. This will be monitored and any children who aren't visible that week will have a follow up wellbeing check from their year group teacher.
- A weekly 'meet' for each year group, for 15 minutes, to be held by the Year group lead, class teachers. Mrs Cliff will also be there to say hello as she misses you all so much!

All previous work from Summer 1 will be archived and we start afresh with the above offer from June 10th. These tasks will be available for a fortnight before they are archived so that the classwork pages are not too overwhelming for you.

We hope that this new way of working will provide a good and manageable range of activities for you and there are more opportunities for you to engage with your year group teacher.

Outdoor Stage

Last week, the new outdoor stage was built and as you can see it looks fantastic. Thank you to all of you who voted for us through the Tesco Bags of Help scheme and for supporting the Friends of Nevill Road, fundraising events.
