Policy steps - classroom

- 1. Remind the child individually of your expectations and which Bee Rule they are breaking.
- 2. STOP and THINK complete restorative sheet during break time within your year group bubble.
- 3. Warning You have 2 choices, if you make a good choice this will happen... if you continue to break the school rules you will be asked to go to your year group buddy class for time out (5 mins)
- 4. Send to buddy class in their year group bubble followed by a restorative meeting to reflect upon behaviour and repair relationships if needed.
- 5. Phase Leader report card after 5 reflection sheets (teacher to contact parents after 3 to inform that behaviour needs improving)
- 6. DHT / HT If more than 1 week on report.
- 7. Meeting with parents if more than 2 weeks on report.

Serious incidents e.g. physical, racist, homophobic, bulling to be reported to Phase Leader immediately, parents/carers informed and logged on SIMS by LJ.

Please note that my plans / one page profiles should be in place for children with additional needs and shared with all staff.

Policy steps - lunchtime

- 1. Remind the child individually of your expectations and which Bee Rule they are breaking.
- 2. Red card given to the child and sent to a member of SLT staff (Yr6 AB, Yr5 NJ, Yr4 JC/LJ, Yr3 JS) to complete a restorative sheet. LJ to log red cards weekly on to SIMS.
- 3. Loss of lunchtime (stay in classroom with member of SLT) and restorative meeting to reflect upon behaviour and repair relationships if needed.
- 4. Phase Leader 5 Restorative sheets completed report card.
- 5. DHT / HT If more than 1 week on report card.
- 6. Meeting with parents if more than 2 weeks

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Wet play arrangements – DVD, colouring and reading only in classrooms. For the last 5 minutes silent reading in preparation for afternoon learning.
