Please see the latest Covid19 guidance from the DFE about the ventilation of classrooms:

In cooler weather windows should be opened just enough to provide constant background ventilation and opened more fully during breaks to purge the air in the space. Opening internal doors

can also assist with creating a throughput of air. If necessary external opening doors may also be used as long as they are not fire doors.

Whilst we must adhere to these guidelines in order to keep our children and staff safe from the risks of Covid, we do not want anyone to feel cold or uncomfortable whilst in school. Therefore, Mr Dunn is checking that the heating is on at all times and I regularly monitor the temperature of all classrooms. Should your child wish to, they are very welcome to wear extra clothing whilst in school.
